The film **Loving Vincent** will also be featured as our contribution to the town's Van Gogh's celebrations which will include the unveiling of a bust of the artist.

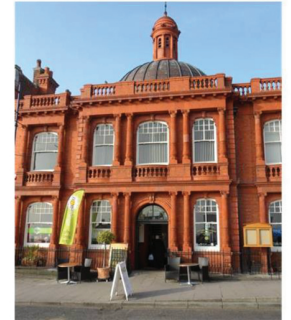

Frederick George Archer is an independent film producer and the CEO of Feorge Films. Frederick started making short films for an award winning advertising company and then worked in sales and distribution for **Rank Video Services** where he developed a passion for scripted films. Documentaries

James Collie set up November Films in 2006 and their first feature length documentary **Beyond Biba** was produced independently over 2008-2009.

The documentary was transmitted in August 2010 on Sky Arts as part of their 60's season and was also sold to television broadcasters in Australia, Brazil and across Europe with the Sundance Channel.

In 2009, November Films released the film **DIY** in the UK, culminating in over 60 cinema screenings across the country followed by a successful DVD release.

Dark Tourism a six part documentary series in association with 3DD Entertainment and **Ashes to Ashes**, a Paris based 15 minute short film in association with the Young Vic Theatre were released in 2011.

Dee Anderson is the daughter of legendary Gerry and Sylvia Anderson – creators of **Thunderbirds**.

Dee was trained in Performing Arts and went on to take part in film, theatre and television productions as an actress and singer. She has just performed at the legendary **Pheasantry** in London's Kings Road, with her band featuring the fabulous jazz pianist **Isaac Asumadu**.

Dee is also an established writer and publisher and launched **Glotime.tv** which has attracted huge coverage in all areas of media including the **BBC**, **Metro** and **The Times**.

She has recently joined the Board of Directors of the **Ramsgate International Film & TV Festival**.

Julie left school at the age of 16 to join the 70's Pop group 'Guys N Dolls'. In the 80's the group moved to Europe and disbanded in 1985, where She and her husband Dominic became successful Country music duo 'Grant & Forsyth' selling over 4 million Albums.

Julie's love of Film has led her to co-write screenplays & co-creating, directing and producing 'Timmy's World' with Tim Clark as a TV Mockumentary (She's also written and sung the 'Timmy's World' theme tune) .

A. W. N. Pugin, master of the Gothic Revival, came to Ramsgate in 1843. He sought to create his ideal of medieval life: a Catholic church and Benedictine monastery, with a family home in their benevolent shadow. That home is The Grange, the idiosyncratic and colourful world of a most brilliant designer.

The Presbytery was started in 1850. This attractive, compact house at the gates of The Grange was intended as a home for the priest who served the church next door. In the 1860s, Pugin's son Edward took residence and added a well-lit studio for his own architectural practice.

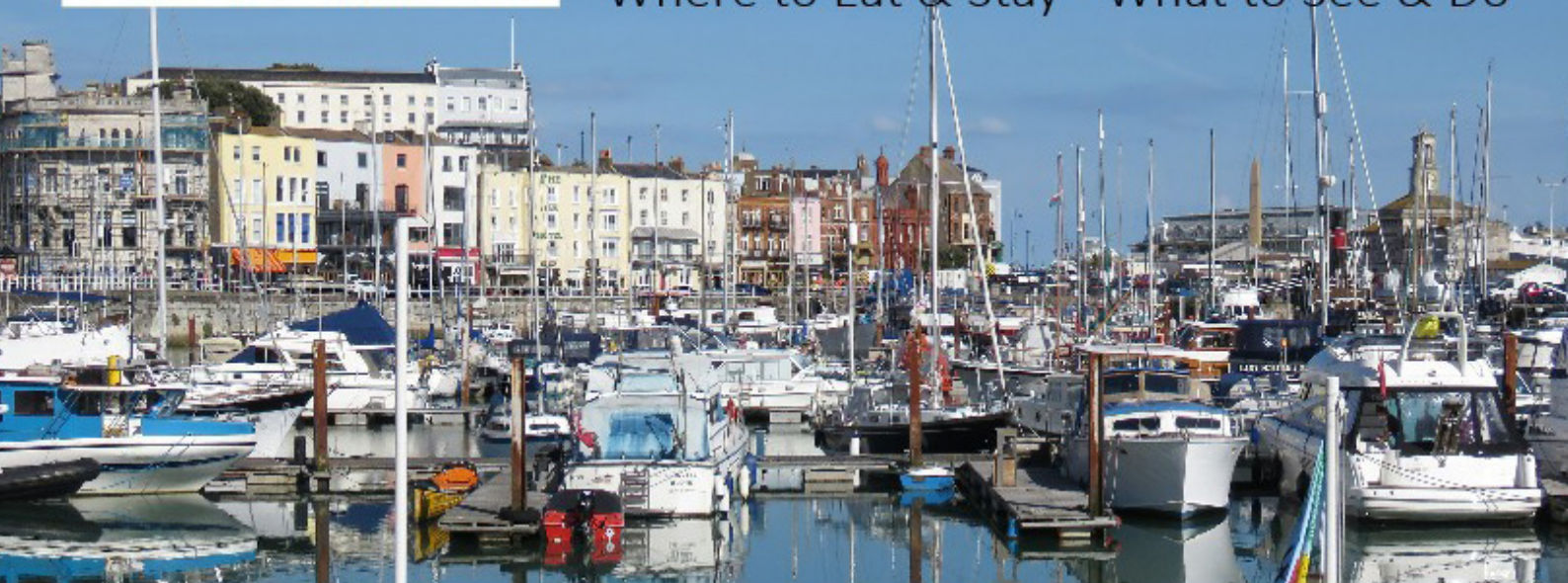

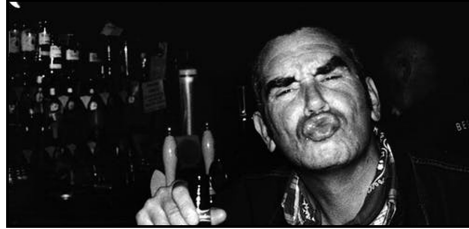

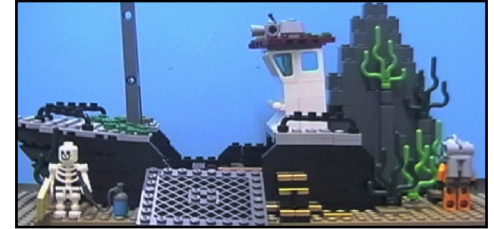
